### BRUTE' AWARD

The Brute' Society of the Diocese of Evansville was formed in 1990 to honor and pay tribute to Catholic lay people who have been recognized by their fellow parishioners as outstanding models of Christian stewardship – people who have been generous of their time, talent, and treasure. The society is named for Bishop Simon Brute' who was appointed the first Bishop of Vincennes (covering five states of the Northwest Territory) in 1834. President John Quincy Adams called Bishop Brute' the "most learned man of his day in America." Membership in the Brute' Society is limited to lay people who are members of one of the parishes of the Diocese of Evansville. They are to be recognized for their volunteer work.

We are requesting from you again this year nominees from our parishes for admission to the Brute' Society for 2009. The St. Joseph Parish Council will receive your nominations and select the inductees for this year. They will be announced by the end of the month.
