## Science: Topic 3 Earth's Land and Water

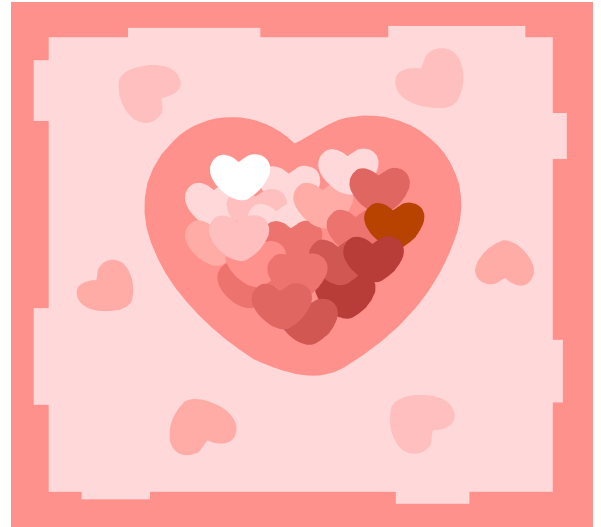
Students will learn about Earth's water and land.
