What We Are Learning

Language Arts

We practiced reading and spelling words with r controlled vowels (or, oar, and ore). We learned that a nursery rhyme is a short rhyme for children that tells a story. Our grammar lessons focused on four conjunctions: and, but, so, and or. Our story this week was After the Fall by Dan Santat.

Math

This week we completed our unit on two-digit addition. We explored adding tens and ones without regrouping. We used place value when adding two-digit numbers, and added two-digit numbers with regrouping. Finally, we practiced expanded form by breaking apart addends to add two-digit numbers.

Religion

We spent the week discussing Holy Week. We learned that Palm Sunday is the first day of Holy Week, and recalls Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. On Holy Thursday, we remember the Last Supper which was the first Mass. On Good Friday, we remember that Jesus chose to die on the cross to save us from our sins. We take up our own crosses by bringing them to Jesus and trusting in His loving care.

Science

We started our unit on The Sky and Earth. We learned that the sun is a star that we see in the daytime and gravity is a force that keeps the moon close to the earth.
