Religion

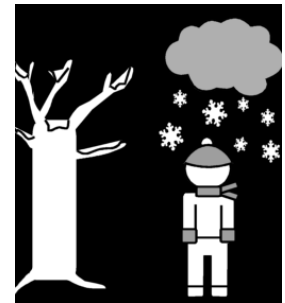
