What We Are Learning

Language Arts

We practiced reading and spelling words with r controlled vowels (ir). We discussed elements of folktales. In grammar, we focused on adverbs of time. Our story this week was Little Red and the Very Hungry Lion by Alex Smith.

Math

We are now working on Addition: Two-Digit Numbers. We started by using place value to find 10 more than a two-digit number. We used models to add multiples of ten. We counted on to add tens to a two-digit number without regrouping.

Religion

We learned that Jesus performed His first miracle at the Wedding Feast of Cana. We also read about how Jesus fed five thousand with two fish and five loaves of bread, and how Jesus calmed the storm. Jesus is God, and He wants us to have faith and believe in Him.

Science
