## What We Are Learning

### Language Arts

We read several fiction and non-fiction stories about dinosaurs. We learned about comparatives and superlatives (adding -er and -est to adjectives). We reviewed long vowels and alphabetical order. Our story this week was If the Dinosaurs Came Back by Bernard Most.

### Math

We explored adding tens and ones without regrouping. We used place value when adding two-digit numbers, and added two-digit numbers with regrouping. Finally, we practiced expanded form by breaking apart addends to add two-digit numbers.

### Religion

We continue our Lenten activities. We also celebrated two special feast days this week. We learned about the life of St. Patrick on Tuesday. We learned more about our patron saint, St. Joseph. His feast day is March 19.

### Science

We enjoyed learning about different kinds of dinosaurs. We discussed reptiles living and extinct. We read about carnivores, herbivores, and omnivores. We learned about fossils and learned that a scientist who studies fossils is called a paleontologist..
