### Language Arts

We practiced reading and spelling words with r controlled vowels (ar). We discussed the central message or lesson of a story. We learned that if a verb ends in an e, we just add d to tell about the past. If a verb ends in a consonant followed by a y, we change the y to i and add ed. Our story this week was The Koala Who Could by Rachel Bright.

### Math

We completed our chapter on subtraction facts to 20 by writing fact families for a given set of numbers. We determined if an equation was true or false, and used addition or subtraction to find a missing part of an equation

### Religion
